DMCI Mining Corporation receives DENR orders

Background/Description of the Disclosure

We would like to inform the investing public that the Company's wholly-owned nickel mining subsidiary, DMCI Mining Corp., received this afternoon, February 15, 2017 from the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), the following orders:

- Order of Suspension of Mining Operations dated February 8, 2017 for Berong Nickel Corp. (BNC)
- Order of Cancellation of Mineral Production Sharing Agreement (MPSA) No. 191-2004 dated February 8, 2017 for Zambales Diversified Metals Corp. (ZDMC)

ZDMC and BNC shall seek redress from the subject DENR Orders raising, among others, the lack of due process and legal bases for the issuance of the same. This shall be done at the soonest possible time and within the reglementary period set by law.

At this point, the Company does not foresee these orders as having any significant, immediate impact on its bottom line, as both nickel companies had not been operating for the most part of 2016.

The Company fully supports BNC and ZDMC's decision to exercise their legal and contractual rights in order to protect the interests of its employees, contractors, host communities and other stakeholders.
