Dear Ms. Manalili,

We reply to your request for clarifications on the news article entitled “DMCI Mining to start new nickel mines in 4th quarter” posted in ManilaStandard.net (Online Edition) on September 10, 2024, wherein it was reported that:

“DMCI Mining Corp. is looking forward to commencing operations of two new nickel mines by the end of the year, according to company president Tulsi Das Reyes.

“We hope to have good news from our Zambales mine in the near future. We’re just waiting for the official response,” Das Reyes said, noting the company already submitted the documentary requirements for the Zambales mine.

The company is also exploring the possibility of opening its mining site in Brooke’s Point, Palawan.

DMCI said it is actively working on securing permits for the nickel projects, with the goal of starting operations soon.

Reyes acknowledged that securing government approvals for permitting takes time, but said he remained optimistic about the prospects.

DMCI is also considering acquiring assets in coal, copper and gold mining sectors over the next two to three years.

DMCI Mining operates open-pit mines in Palawan and Zambales through subsidiaries Berong Nickel Corp. (BNC) and Zambales Diversified Metals Corp. (ZDMC).

Subject to obtaining the necessary regulatory and permitting approvals, we confirm the potential commencement of operations for two new nickel mines under our subsidiary, DMCI Mining, by the end of the year. These mines are located in Santa Cruz, Zambales and Long Point (Aborlan, Palawan).

To clarify a point from the referenced news article, DMCI Mining President Mr. Tulsi Das Reyes, was referring to the company’s Long Point mine in Aborlan, Palawan, not Brooke’s Point.

DMC remains committed to responsible mining practices and sustainable development. The company is continuously evaluating new mining projects and opportunities in line with its strategic objectives and environmental standards.

DMCI Holdings, Inc. will continue to provide timely updates to the investing public regarding any significant developments related to its mining operations.
